Collection and Use of your Personal Information

Sections of Spaulding's website requests personally identifiable information including your name, address, phone numbers, and e-mail address. Please note that individuals visiting the site are never required to provide any information.

This information is used to process your order and payment, and to communicate with you about the status of your online transaction. Credit card information is used only for processing payment and is not retained on the Site.

Spaulding does not sell, rent, lease, trade or disclose identifying information of our website users. Information gathered is used solely for the benefit of Spaulding.

Log Data
